From I-94 in Kalamazoo, take the Sprinkle Road exit (Exit 80) and proceed north. There is a stop light at the intersection of Sprinkle Road with Gull Road. Make a left onto Gull Road and drive about 1/8th mile to the **Gull Crossing Mall parking lot**. Watch for the **‘Sambodh Society Shuttle’ sign** near the north central parking lot entrance. (NOTE: This is the same place, as previous years, but K-Mart is gone.) Then, after the Program, our Shuttle Service will provide return transportation to all guests and participants to this same Gull Crossings Parking lot on Gull Road.

About the Rituals

Rudrabhishekam and Chandi Homa

For the abundant blessings of the Universal parents, Shiva and Shakti; for devotion and final liberation.

Maha Rudrabhishekam: To wash away all sins and afflictions; bring peace, prosperity and happiness and family togetherness. (Also **Anu Lingam**) Both on **Sunday**

Chandi Homa: To receive blessings from Goddess Chandi-Ma Vaishno Devi - for peace, prosperity and spiritual attainment. (Also **Laghu Chandi**) Both on **Sunday**

Lakshmi-Narayan Puja and Homa: For increase in wealth and success in business. **Saturday**

Hanuman Puja: For mental strength, intellectual vigor and physical stamina, curing all kinds of mental illnesses, courage and perseverance. **Saturday**

Mahamrityunjaya Homa: For relief from chronic mental and physical illness. **Saturday**

Ganapati Homa: For removing hurdles in business, work place, relationships and personal growth. **Sunday**

Navagraha Homa: For procuring, maintaining and enhancing wealth, health, for reputation and family well-being. **Sunday**

Gavatri Homa: For students enhancing memory power, concentration, recall and self application for securing good grades and admission to good colleges. **Sunday**

Statement by Swami Bodhananda Saraswati

The power of rituals which use a combination of *mantra*, *tantra* and *yantra* are far greater in organizing the forces of nature in supplicant's favor than mere prayer which is often said without much faith or concentration. The *Vedas* prescribe many rituals for fulfillment of legitimate human desires: for worthy children, happy family life, health, wealth, recognition, professional success, as well as for peace of mind here and hereafter.

Sambodh Society (SCHE) is organizing a rare Vedic ritual of propitiating *Shiva* and *Shakti*, and other aspects of God, to fulfill our individual and collective desires. Unique for both Hindu and non-Hindu Americans, these rituals take us back to ancient Vedic times and give us the opportunity to experience authentic Vedic culture and religion. Eleven traditionally trained practicing *Ritwiks*, under the leadership of *Yajurveda Shastri* Shri Aswath and *Rigveda Shastri* Pradip Sagdeo, will be officiating over this momentous ceremony. This provides a rare opportunity to worship *Shiva* and *Shakti* in a forest ambience, the largest *Shiva* Lingam and *Shakti Pitham* in the whole of America.
