

# Spiritual Stories for Children – Coming Soon!



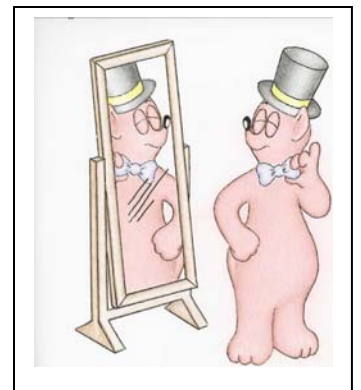
## About the Author

Lois writes about the issues children face and, through story-telling, offers youth appropriate solutions based upon universal spiritual values. Lois became inspired to write such stories when she was first exposed to Vedanta in 2002. Her second story evolved out of her attending a retreat and listening to Swami Bodhananda teaching the message of the *Bhagavad Gita*. ## About the Stories

**Book 1: Me and You—We are Who?** The supporting theme of the first story is sharing, egoless-ness, and non-separateness, couched in a dialogue between two children who struggle over their differences. The story is written in rhyme and meter rendering the reading both delightful and appropriate for grade-school children.

**Book 2: All the Happiness There Is!** The second story is about happiness and develops through a child who goes from object to object trying to find happiness in the exterior world. With the help of her grandmother she is able to realize the inner source of happiness. In both cases, adults provide wisdom and guidance, a theme often missing in present-day publications for children.
